Referent for center of Italy of patients with Prader-Willi syndrome (he follows more than 180 PWS patients).

The focus of his research and clinical work is in many fields of paediatric endocrinology.

In particular, in the last 10 years, he has a special interest in poliglandular autoimmune diseases, autoimmune diseases associated to diabetes mellitus type 1, rare diseases and genetic obesities, particularly in Prader-Willi syndrome.

As far as Prader-Willi syndrome is concerned, the research programme actually run focuses both on aspects of GH deficiency, gonadal dysfunction and glucose metabolism alterations in pediatric subjects with PWS.

In addition, his working group performs research on sleep abnormalities and neuropsychological profile.

Recently he is evaluating the use and effectiveness of bioenteric intragastric balloon (BIB) for treatment of severe obesity in PWS patients.

He participated to many national and international meetings, congresses and advanced postgraduate courses.

He has organized medical congresses and scientific meetings and he collaborates with many scientific institutions either national or international.

The scientific activity has provided many abstracts of oral presentations and posters in both national and international congresses, as well as publications, on international journals
